Anne Jackson is a contemporary textile artist who works through the medium of knotted tapestry to express ideas and examine issues that interest her. In the past she was known for her series of 'Old Masters' tapestries, which often involved turning the tables on the idea of the female nude in art, or commenting on the art world in general. Most recently she has embarked on a series of large-scale tapestries, 'The Witchcraft Series', looking at the history of witchcraft and ideas surrounding it, inspired by the fact that the last people executed for witchcraft were hung in her local town, Exeter.
