Internationally known textile artist Sasha Kagan has built a multi faceted knitwear design business from her isolated home in mid-Wales.

She studied Fine Art and Printmaking at Exeter College of Art and the Royal College of Art respectively. This led her to a fascination with William Morris and the Arts and Crafts movement. On moving to Wales hand knitting became her main medium to create the wonderful nature inspired designs which have become her trade-mark.

Sasha has published six books as well as contributing to many books and magazines over the years. Her most recent books "Crochet Inspiration" published by Sixth and Spring ISBN 9781933027 and "Knitwear" published by GMC ISBN 9781861085191 continue her exploration of hand crafted textiles using both knit and crochet.

Her mission is to inspire the hand crafter to be creative and to enjoy the process of making textiles by hand.

She will give a slide presentation of her designs followed by questions and a book signing at Fibrefest on August 22nd and 23rd at 12 noon in the cinema.
